CONDITIONS

- Water can only be drawn at the following designated locations within the Kapiti Coast district between the following times:

- Paraparaumu Council Depot - Fyfefield Place **7:30AM & 4:00PM**
Monday to Friday
- Waikanae Council Depot – 34 Rangihiroa Street **7:30AM & 4:00PM**
Monday to Friday
- Otaki Council Depot – Aotaki Street **24hr Access** available.

Any person/company intending to take water from a dedicated filling point in the Kapiti Coast District must complete an application to the Operational Services department, Kapiti Coast District Council. Permits are not assignable to any other party & are required to be renewed on an annual basis unless otherwise specified.

- All transportation and usage of water shall be restricted to within the boundaries of the Kapiti Coast District. Any person/company found to be in breach of this requirement will result in immediate revocation of the permit.
- Use of the water for any purpose other than that which is stated on this application, or which creates a potential hazard to the water system, will result in immediate revocation of the permit.
- The Applicant shall comply with the Water Supply Protection Regulations 1961 by taking steps to prevent backflow to the water main. To obtain a permit, a tanker or other container must be fitted with a backflow prevention device.
- Any person willfully or negligently causing damage to any fire hydrant or filling point in the District shall be liable for all costs associated with the repair and restoration of such to full service.
- If water is to be taken for potable purposes the Applicant must obtain and provide a copy of Registered Water Carrier Certificate from the Ministry of Health or approved equivalent. The Certification must demonstrate that the water tank will be disinfected and is suitable for the transport of potable water.
- This permit is revocable at any time at the discretion of the Operations Manager, Reticulation Supervisor or Water & Wastewater Asset Manager.
- This permit must be carried/displayed at all times.
