Council Offices & Service Centres

Rimu Road, Waikanae and Ōtaki offices will close at 3pm on Friday 23 December and reopen Wednesday 28 December. After New Year offices will reopen on Wednesday 4 January 2012. Office hours are 8am – 5pm.

Rubbish and Recycling collections

This will carry on as normal through the holiday period, including the Monday and Tuesday public holidays after Christmas and New Year.

Please make sure your bag and bin are kerbside before 7.30am on the day of collection.

Transfer Stations

The district's transfer stations are only closed on Christmas Day and New Year's Day.

Ōtaki and Otaihangā are open from 9am – 5pm on 26 December and 2 January. Waikanae opens from midday – 5pm on these days.

Liquor Bans

A liquor ban will be in place between 8pm and 8am from 24 December to 5 January inclusive, along the entire length of the beach, foreshore, dunes and adjoining car parks and reserves within the jurisdiction of the Kāpiti Coast District Council.

The ban also applies to the Paraparaumu Beach retail area.

A permanent year-round liquor ban applies at the Waikanae Park skateboard area and wrestling club carpark, the Main Street and Mill Road area of Ōtaki and the State Highway One retail area in Ōtaki.

Liquor is banned from the Tasman Road/Marine Parade area of Ōtaki Beach between the hours of 10pm to 8am Thursday to Sunday, throughout the year.
