# PRIORITY PROJECTS

We want our town centres to be vibrant, diverse and thriving – places where people want to spend time and where they can access the services they need safely. The town centres project is about using the opportunities created by the Expressway to transform and improve the Paraparaumu and Waikanae town centres. Work has been scheduled in a 14-year programme of activity to achieve the transformation.

In the past couple of years we have been working with the community and businesses to develop concepts for the transformation of Waikanae town centre. In June 2015 the budgets were approved through the Council’s Long Term Plan. In December 2015 we engaged a team led by Brian Perry Civil to manage the design and construction phases of the project.

There are seven building block projects that make up the Waikanae town centre transformation. Some of these require partnerships with the NZ Transport Agency, Greater Wellington Regional Council or the private sector to bring them to fruition. In the 14-year programme of work we have identified the first priority projects to work on.

The first set of projects is centred on SH1 turning into a local road within two years of the Expressway opening. These projects include the upgrade of the Te Moana/SH1 intersection, the SH1 Revocation (transformation into a local road) and the connection of the transport hub to the town centre (across SH1).

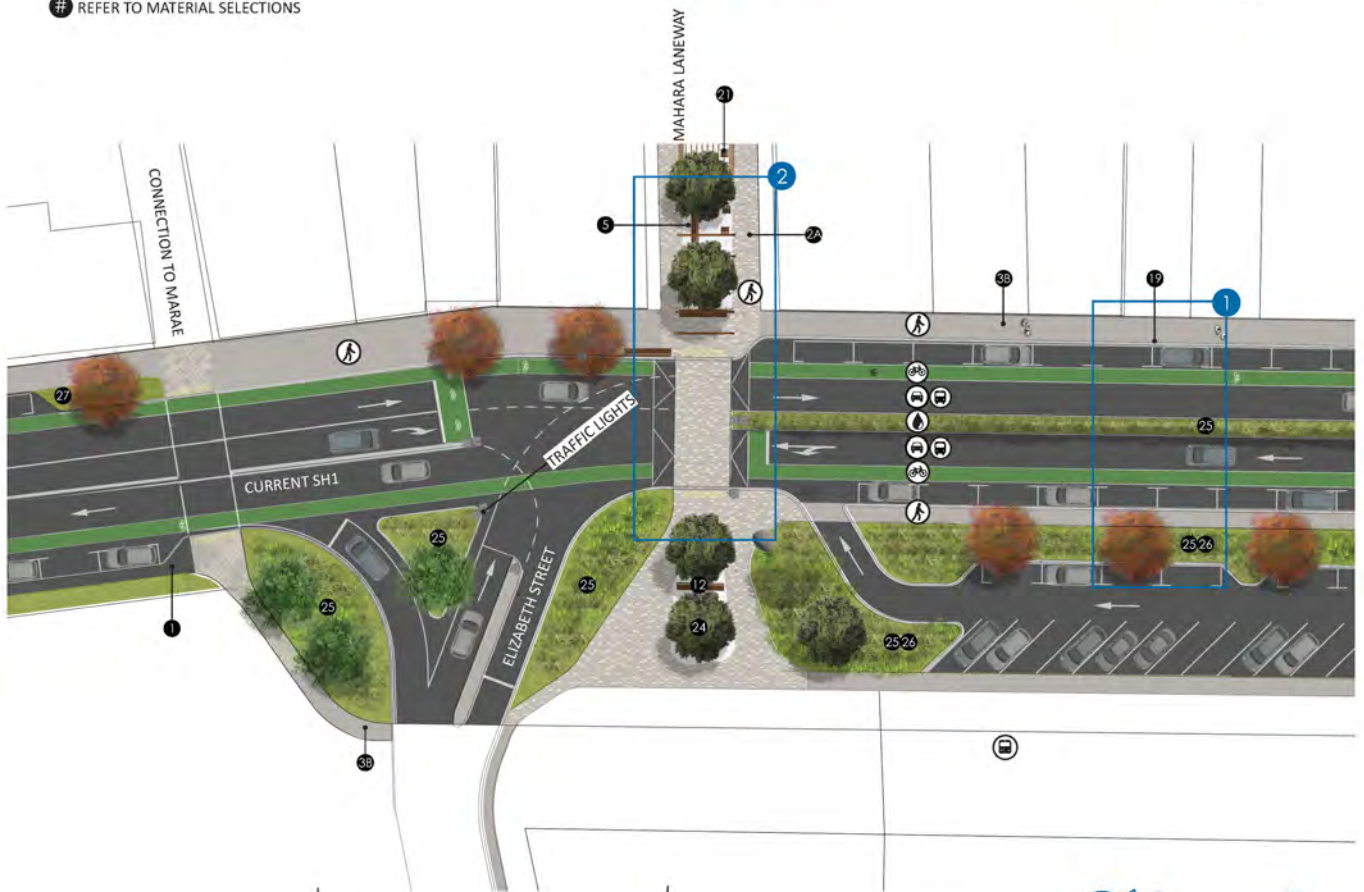

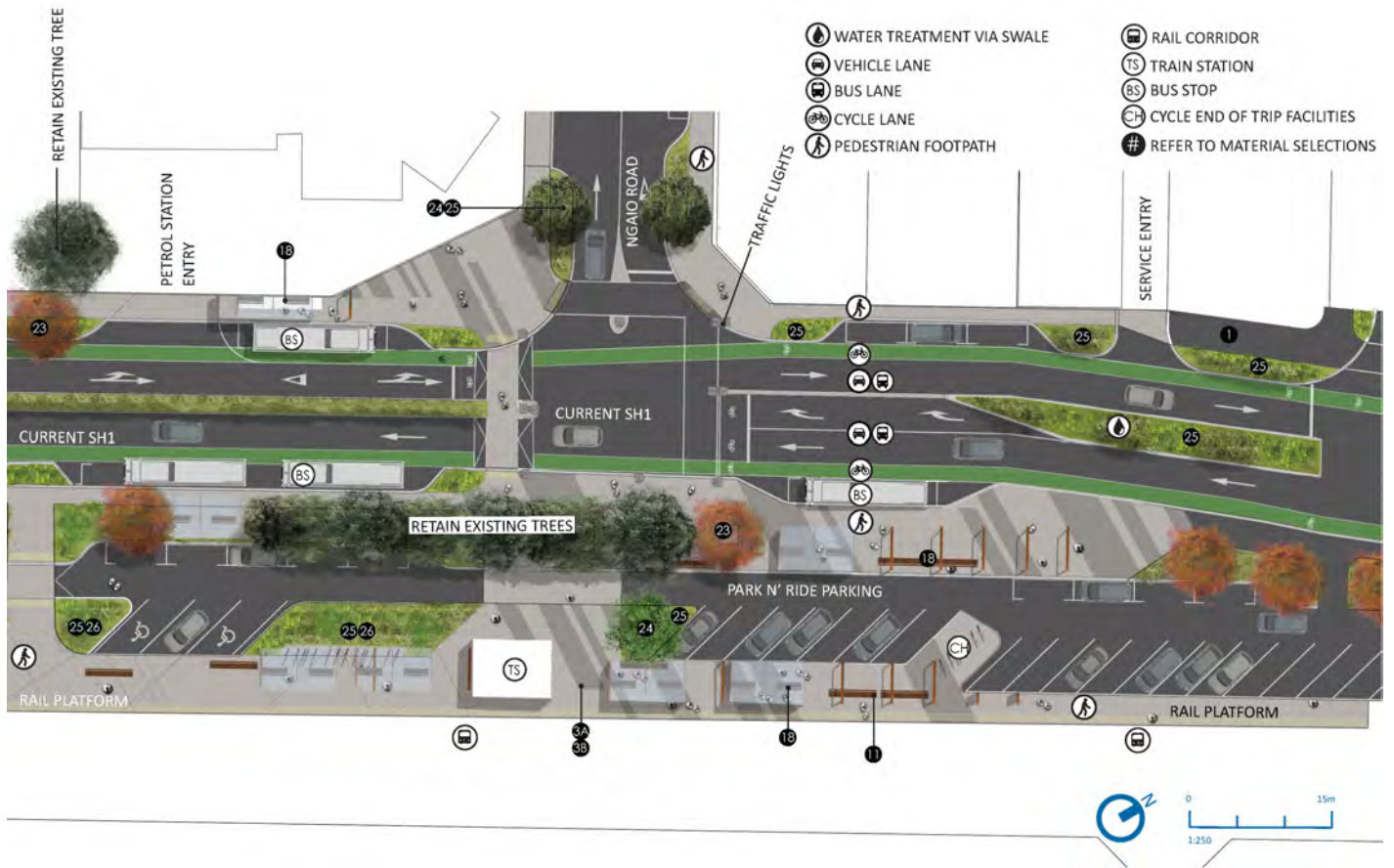

### PAVING

#### 1 Paving - Asphalt footpath

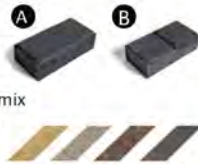
Hot mix asphalt paving as per Kāpiti Coast District Council standards and specifications.



#### 2 Paving - Firth pavers

Firth 'Classic' collection

- A) 200x100x50mm holland paver - Earth tone mix
- B) 200x100x50mm (100x100mm appearance) holland set - Earth tone mix



#### 3 Paving - U5 concrete

- A) 8kg/m<sup>2</sup> 330c 'black' oxide
- B) 4kg/m<sup>2</sup> 330c 'black' oxide



#### 4 Paving - Exposed aggregate concrete

Concrete with 20mm local aggregates. Exposed aggregate dark oxide finish.



#### 5 Paving - Granular pavement



#### 6 Paving - Cycle lane

Green, high-friction, anti-skid aggregates.



#### 7 Kerb - Concrete kerb and channel

Development of Kāpiti Coast District Council standard kerb and edge details for the town centre to provide a consistent identity and quality urban framework.



#### 8 Crossings - Pedestrian and vehicle

Development of Kāpiti Coast District Council standard drop kerb details for the town centre to provide a consistent identity and quality urban framework.



#### 9 Tactile indicators

Freedom Strategies 'Guidemaster' range of warning and directional tactile pavers and individual studs.

## FURNITURE & LIGHTING

### FURNITURE

#### 10 Seat - 1 person

Metalco 'Riva' seat. L 750mm x W 575mm x H 835mm. Powder coated cast aluminium frame and armrest. 32x130mm section hardwood slats.



#### 11 Seat - 3 person

Metalco 'Riva' seat. L 1750mm x W 575mm x H 835mm. Powder coated cast aluminium frame and armrest. 32x130mm section hardwood slats.



#### 12 Seat - 6 person

Metalco 'Riva' seat. L 3000mm x W 575mm x H 835mm. Powder coated cast aluminium frame and armrest. 32x130mm section hardwood slats.



#### 13 Seat - Stone

Urban Effects 'Moonstone' or 'Stone' seat. L 2240mm x W 2140mm. Stone form made of granite or stone in reconstituted marble, sandblasted or polished.



#### 14 Rubbish bin - Spencer rubbish bin

Metalco 'Spencer' bin powder coated with recycling infographics. Mounted to light poles where appropriate to reduce clutter.



#### 15 Cycle stand

ABES 'Gate' cycle stand powder coated.



#### 16 Bollard - Fixed or removable

ABES 'Metropol 0RK' bollard powder coated. Options for fixed or removable bases cast in concrete footing. Lighting options also to be considered.



#### 17 Timber structures - Custom

Modern timber, vertical, pergola and kiosk structures to provide navigation, shelter and shade throughout Mahara Place.



#### 18 Timber bus shelter - Custom

Bus shelters are required throughout the town centre. Designs will be investigated and assessed against the NZTA guidelines for public transport infrastructure and facilities.



### LIGHTING

#### 19 Light poles and lights

Manufacturer 'WE-EF' LED street light side fixed to 6m high powder coated flange mount pole. Pole fitted with 'Flagtrax' flag installation system.



#### 20 Tree uplights - LED

Manufacturer 'WE-EF' in-ground tree uplight. Mounted within concrete.



#### 21 Overhead lighting

Manufacturer 'WE-EF' LED overhead light. Suspended on stainless steel wires.
