In accordance with Section 136 of the Act, the Committee chose to hear and determine the application without notice.


INTRODUCTION

This is the second application by R K J P Services Limited for a Temporary Authority Order to operate an On-Licence in respect of premises situated at 5 Coastlands Parade, Paraparaumu, known as 'Spice Hut'. The applicant has lodged an application for an On Licence, and seeks a Temporary Authority order to enable them to sell alcohol at the restaurant while the On Licence application is processed. The previous Temporary Authority expired on 20 October 2017 and the applicant is not currently selling any alcohol.

DECISION

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in Section 136 of the Act. We grant the applicant a Temporary Authority Order to operate On-Licence number 45/ON/029/2014, at premises known as Spice Hut, situated at 5 Coastlands Parade, Paraparaumu, under the existing terms and conditions of the licence, set to expire on 7 August 2015 (still valid due to lodgement of application for renewal prior to this date). The Temporary Authority will expire on 26 January 2018. We have taken into account that the Applicant did not file an application for a new licence prior to the previous Temporary Authority expiring. The Applicant has now applied for a new licence which is being processed.
