#### Applications to the Community Grants Fund

- 5 <u>Ōtaki College</u>
- 5.1 Ōtaki College has requested \$500 to assist with event catering expenses for an event to commemorate the sinking of the SS Ōtaki.
- 5.2 The Lions Club of Ōtaki is sponsoring the development of a bike pump track at Haruatai Park and is holding a book fair on 7 April. The Club requests a grant of \$500 to pay for the hireage of the Ōtaki Railway Station (five days hire at \$100 a day) to allow for setting up, sorting books and cleaning up after the event.

- 1. Unique or infrequent events which are important to the Ōtaki Ward;
- 2. Special events that will promote the town and enhance opportunities within the town;
- 3. Activities that encourage the development of cultural, environmental, social or educational activities within the Ōtaki Ward;
