# About preparing a submission on a proposed plan change

### Submission

The "Medium Density Residential Standards" (MDRS), & its potential effects on the lifestyle of New Zealanders, is the most disturbing & unsettling piece of legislation.

New Zealand, sadly ,compared to a number of other overseas countries ,has few enough urban /suburban, well established, attractive, green,low density residential neighbourhoods-some of which are of "Heritage" importance.

Based on the proposed District Plan Change 2, it would appear that KCDC has no interest in supporting these.

The proposed ,virtually unfettered, construction of 3 storey, & in some places up to 6 storey, buildings in these areas is horrifying & , to our mind, potential urban vandalism --&, once destroyed, the character of these areas will never be replaceable.

On a personal level, we made a positive decision to move to the Waikanae Garden Precint a while ago, exactly because of its feeling of peace, low density housing, green space & proximity to ameneties. This was to be our "forever house" as we grow older, & we have invested a huge amount of emotion, time, energy & money in the property. We made these decisions based on the wholly reasonable expectation that the Waikane Garden Precint would remain largely as it is.

And we know that we are not alone in this

The thought of any, or all ,of our neighbours being able to erect tall, high density housing on our boundaries, without consultation ,is profoundly depressing.

The effect on our light ,privacy, & the environment would be unacceptably detrimental.

It is chilling to read on the proposed amendment documentation that......

"It is anticipated that the character of the Waikanae Garden Precint will change over time "... & that there will be ..... "No specific rules for building density or subdivision associated with the Wakanae Garden Precinct"

We ,therefore ,strongly oppose the proposed Kapiti Coast District Plan amendments as above, particularly as they relate to the Waikanae Garden Precint.
