Please provide all internal communications (as in emails, memos, instructions related to signage on Rimu Road.

Please find attached the communications that Council holds in relation to your request.

The personal details of some individuals have been withheld from the information provided. The decision to withhold this information is made under section 7(2)(a) of the Act which allows for Council to withhold information in order to protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons. I am satisfied that the withholding of this information is not outweighed by public interest considerations in section 7(1) favouring release.

Please note that some of the documentation provided includes information not related to your request. This information has been removed and marked as out of scope.

Kia Ora Janet,

Yesterday Richard asked me to follow up on two large signs (Candidate McCann) within the designated Rimu Road permitted location. There was concern that the two signs may exceed the 3.0 m² size limit.

Permitted Sign Location - Rimu Road

One of Candidate McCann signs is displayed within the approved location and measures 2.88 m², which is within the permitted size. This sign is **compliant.**


Private Property - Ngahina Developments Limited

Election signs are permitted on private property with the consent of the property owner.

- Given the proximity of the second sign to the permitted Rimu Road location, I will be requesting that Candidate McCann provide written consent from the property owner.
- I also observed one of your signs attached to the fence in the same area. If you intend to leave it there, please provide confirmation of property owner consent as well.

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
