<b>Resource Consents</b>			<p><u>Appeals</u></p> <p>There are currently no Appeals to the Environment Court.</p> <p><u>Notified Applications</u></p> <p>The application to establish an Apartment Complex with Ground Floor Retail and associated Unit-Title Subdivision at 2 Matatua Road, Raumati Beach (RM130217) was notified on 16 January 2014. Submissions closed on 14 February 2014 and eight submissions were received (2 in support, 2 conditional support, 1 neutral, and 3 oppose). A hearing has been set down to commence at 9am on Wednesday 19th March 2014. The hearings panel has been confirmed as Crs Ammundsen, Lloyd, and Gurunathan. Four submitters will be speaking to their submission at the hearing.</p> <p>Council has also received an application for a Notice of Requirement for a minor alteration to the MacKays to Peka Peka Designation (RM140006) involving several Chitton Drive and one Mazengarb</p>	

			<p>Road property. The application is being processed by way of limited notification with notice served on ten properties. Notice was served on 14/02/2014. The submission period closes 14/03/2014. Following the closure of the submission period a report will be prepared and a hearing held. The Council does not have decision making powers on the application, but it may make a recommendation to the requiring authority to either:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Confirm the requirement;</li> <li>• Modify the requirement;</li> <li>• Impose conditions; or</li> <li>• Withdraw the requirement.</li> </ul>	
<b>Collmog Bridge</b>			<p>Following the decision reached at the last Regulatory Management Committee meeting, officers have reissued section 124 notices with an expiry date of 31 May 2014. We have also issued infringement notices following the non-compliance with the section 124 notice that expired on 29 November 2013.</p>
