Request for Information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) (the LGOIMA)

Thank you for your request for information of **24 December 2025**, and further email of **8 January 2026** confirming the date range for your request. You have requested the following information:

I would like to understand the typical time taken between lodgement and approval of non-complying consents. Please provide a breakdown of consents that did not comply with the District Plan and have been approved by the District Council - specifically the number of working days between lodgement and consent, and whether any further information was required (impacting the processing time).

Please find attached reports showing processing days from lodgement of resource consent applications received through to date the decision was issued by council and resource consents where further information was requested.

The reports are for the period 1 January 2021 through to 31 December 2025.

Note, not all resource consents are required because an activity or proposal 'does not comply' with the district plan. There are a number of uses and development types such as sub-divisions that require resource consent because that is the default status i.e., they do not breach any permitted standards, they are specified as immediately requiring a resource consent.
