CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING

PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1 Nine applications for a Discretionary Grant have been received:
 - Confidence 4 Kids Limited (C4U)
 - The Light House Family Trust
 - Kapiti Coast Rugby League (2004) Inc
 - Diesel Club
 - Dean Hapeta
 - Jacinta Beckley
 - Our Lady of Fatima Parish
 - Parkinson's Kapiti Horowhenua
 - Kapiti Women's Community Choir
- 2 These applications comply with the Discretionary Grants criteria and need to be considered by the Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board.

SIGNIFICANCE OF DECISION

- 3 The Council's Significance Policy is not triggered by this report.

BACKGROUND

- 4 An amount of \$21,022 is provided in the 2013/14 budget for the Community Grants Fund. An amount of \$500 was returned by a previous grant recipient who was injured and therefore unable to complete.
- 5 This means a total of \$21,522 is available for allocation in the current financial year.
- 6 This report will be the third allocation of grants in the 2013/14 year.

CONSIDERATIONS

Issues

- 7 Grants are allocated in accordance with established criteria (copies provided under separate cover).
- 8 All applicants have been advised of the criteria and meeting date by email, telephone or letter.

Applications to the Community Grant Fund

Confidence 4 Kids Limited (C4U)

- 9 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with hall hire costs to run their workshops.
- 10 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 5: *The remission of hall rental within the current financial year of the project or activity.*

The Light House Family Trust

- 11 An original application for \$304.25 was sought to assist with the cost of purchasing ten booster seats for vehicles at their child care facility, in order to comply with new child restraint laws effective in November 2013. Since this application was received, and due to a delay in Community Board meeting dates, the Light House Family Trust were obliged to go ahead with the purchase of the booster seats, as the new legislation has now come into effect.
- 12 They have subsequently amended their application to \$500, to assist with the cost of installing seat harnesses in their vans instead. A quote for this has been provided.
- 13 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity*

Kapiti Coast Rugby League (2004) Inc.

- 14 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of hiring fields for their 2013 Tag Season.
- 15 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity*

Diesel Club (Dyslexic Club)

- 16 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with costs associated with the setting up of the Diesel Club.
- 17 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity*

Dean Hapeta

- 18 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with costs associated with holding the 'Reggae at the Beach' event in Raumati, in January 2014.
- 19 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity*

Jacinta Beckley

- 20 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with costs associated with attending the NZ U20 Women's Basketball Champs in Perth, in February 2014.

- 21 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity*

Our Lady of Kapiti Parish Events

- 22 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with costs associated with holding the fundraising Christmas luncheon at Southwards Car Museum, in December 2013.
- 23 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity*

Parkinson's Society Kapiti Horowhenua Inc

24. Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with administration costs of the Society's local office.
- 25 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity*

Kapiti Women's Community Choir

- 26 Funding of \$500 is sought for the purpose of remission of hall hire costs for the Kapiti Uniting Church Hall in Raumati Beach.
- 27 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 5: *The remission of hall rental within the current financial year of the project or activity.*

Financial Considerations

- 28 An amount of \$21,022 is provided in the 2013/14 budget for the Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Grants Fund. An amount of \$500 was returned by a previous grant recipient who was injured and therefore unable to complete.
- 29 A total of \$21,522 is therefore available for allocation in the current financial year.
