

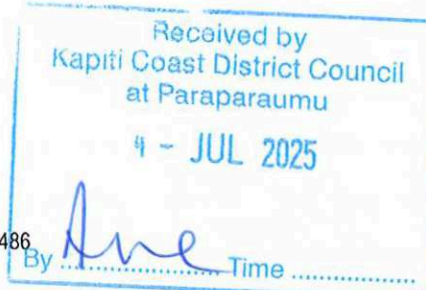

## Guidance for Completing On-Licence Application Form

### Background

The object of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 is that the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol should be undertaken safely and responsibly; and the harm caused by the excessive or inappropriate consumption of alcohol should be minimised.

It is a legal requirement of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 that you must have a licence before you can sell or supply alcohol.

### Before lodging application

If your application for a NEW licence is regarding 'premises - not a conveyance', you must also apply for certificate of compliance with the Resource Management Act and the Building Act from the Kapiti Coast District Council. A 'conveyance' means an aircraft, coach, ferry, hovercraft, ship, train, or other vehicle, used to transport people.

I am writing to formally request an extension to our current licensed trading hours. We are seeking to adjust our liquor licence to allow trading from 9:00am instead of 10:00am and to extend our evening hours from 11:00pm to 12:00am.

This proposed change aims to support both our business growth and broader community benefits, and we respectfully ask that the Kapiti Coast District Council consider the following points in support of this application:

### **1. Increased Employment Opportunities**

Extending our trading hours will allow us to create additional shifts, offering more hours to our existing team. This is particularly important in the current economic climate, where supporting stable, local employment is key to regional recovery and growth.

### **2. Supporting Tourism and the Local Economy**

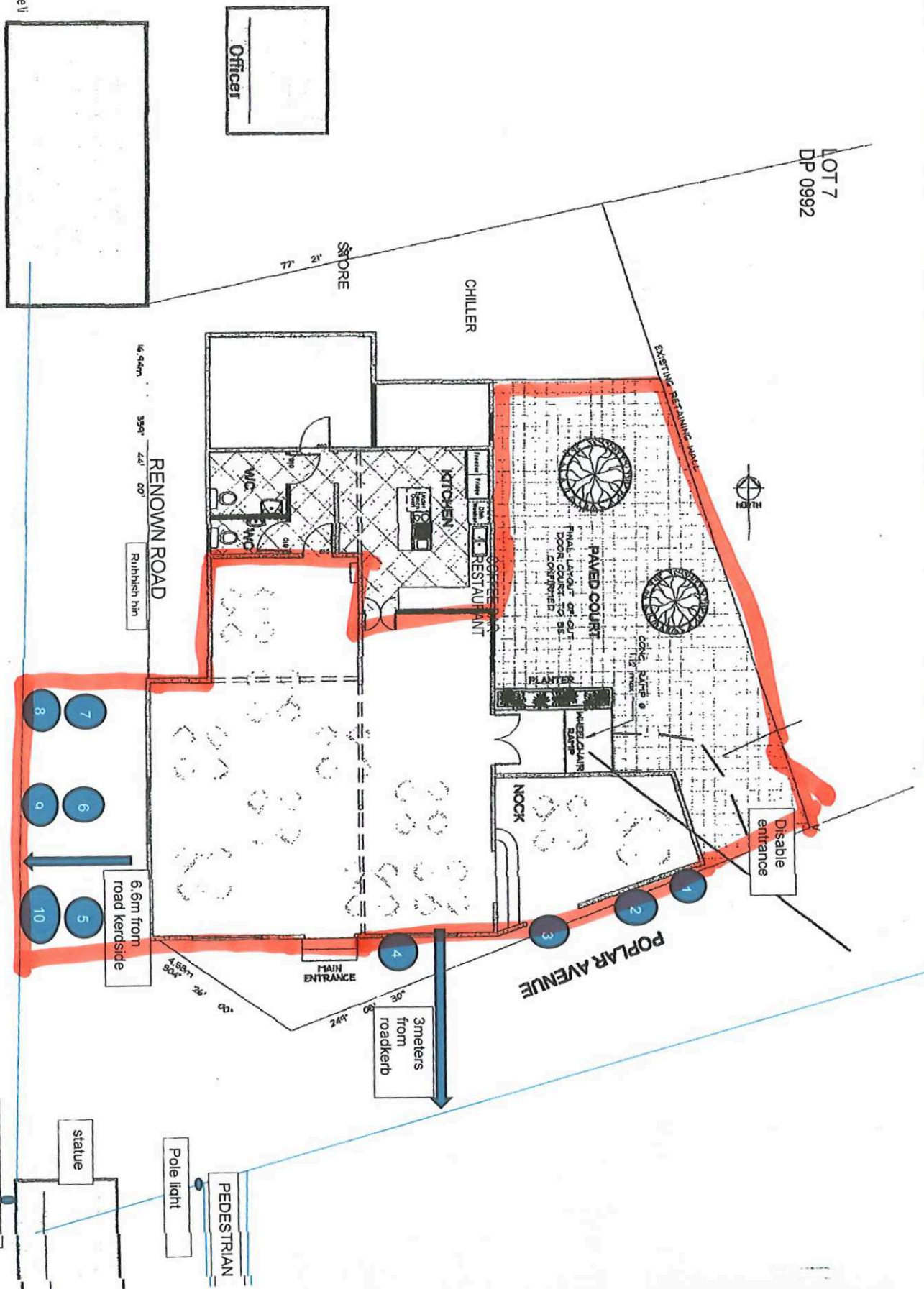


