They advise their Pest Management Plan is subject to the Ministry of Primary Industry providing a national policy on the matter, which should occur in 2015.</p> <p>February 2015 GWRC confirm the National Policy Direction from the Ministry of Primary Industries is expected by mid-2015, after which GWRC will begin a review of their Regional Pest Management Plan. At the time of the review they will consider the request for inclusion of Canada geese in that Plan.</p> <p>April 2015 This matter was included in the Council's submission to GWRC's Long Term Plan which was sent on 20 April.</p>
