PROCEDURE MATTERS

In accordance with s136(3) of the Act, the Committee chose to hear and determine the application without notice.

INTRODUCTION

This is an application by Xinyu Meng for a Temporary Authority Order to operate the On Licence in respect of the premises situated at 36 Marine Parade, Paraparaumu, known as "The Office Cafe".

The Temporary Authority is required to enable the applicant to sell and supply alcohol for consumption on the premises in the interim period between purchase of premises and the determination of an application for a new substantive On Licence. The order would permit alcohol to be sold pursuant to the conditions and obligations of the existing licence in effect under the previous owner/licensee.


Comments have been requested from the Police and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

DECISION

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in the s136(3) of the Act. We grant the applicant a Temporary Authority Order to operate On Licence number 045/ON/002/2014 under the existing terms and conditions, for a period of three months effective from the date of decision or date of issue of the order, if they are not the same date.

The order may issue immediately.
