CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING

PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1 Three applications for funding have been received:
 - Kapiti College Girls Tennis Team
 - Paraparaumu Beach Bowling Club
 - Rotary Club of Kapiti

DELEGATION

- 2 The Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board has delegated authority as at section D.10 of the Governance Structure approved by Council on 11 June 2015:

Community Grants

10.13 *Authority to consider and approve the allocation of community-based grant funds as deemed appropriate under agreed criteria of both existing schemes and any granting schemes that may be approved through the Annual Plan process or the LTP process.*

BACKGROUND

- 3 An amount of \$21,506 is provided in the 2015/16 budget for the Community Grants Fund and is available for allocation in that financial year.
- 4 To date the amount of \$14,267.40 has been granted in the current financial year.
- 5 The amount of \$7,238.60 remains available for granting in the current financial year.
- 6 Accountability reports on grants allocated are required two months after the event or activity for which the grant was awarded takes place.
- 7 The applicant has been advised of the meeting date by email.

CONSIDERATIONS

- 8 Grants are allocated in accordance with established criteria (copies provided under separate cover).

Applications to the Discretionary Grants Fund

Kapiti College Girls Tennis Team

- 9 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the costs for the team to compete in a national college tournament being held in Auckland, from 4 – 7 April 2016.
- 10 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special Project or Activity*.

Paraparaumu Beach Bowling Club

- 11 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost for four teams to compete in the Bowls New Zealand National Playoffs to be held in Hamilton, commencing 17 April 2016.
- 12 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special Project or Activity*.

Rotary Club of Kapiti

- 13 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of the Kapiti Coast District Council resource consent fee required to hold car boot sales every month during daylight saving months in the Kapiti Coast region.
- 14 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 4: *To partially or fully offset the cost of any Council permit, licence or resource consent fees*.
