Council services over Christmas & New Year

Ōtaki Service Centre

Closes at 3pm, Tuesday 24 December and re-opens at 9am, Friday 27 December.

Closes at 5pm, Tuesday 31 December and re-opens at 9am, Friday 3 January.

Open as normal on all other dates i.e. Monday to Friday from 9am until 5pm.

Ōtaki Library

Closes at 3pm on Tuesday 24 December.

Closed on Wednesday 25/Thursday 26 December and Wednesday 1/Thursday 2 January.

Open as normal on all other dates:

- Monday to Friday: 9am-5pm
- Saturday: 10am-4pm
- Sunday: closed

Ōtaki Pool

Closed on Christmas Day, 25 December only.

Opening hours:

- Weekdays: 6am-8pm (7pm closing on Tuesdays)
- Weekends & public holidays: 8am-6pm

Ōtaki Resource Recovery Centre

Closed Christmas Day and New Year's Day.

Open as normal on all other dates:

- Monday to Saturday: 8am-5pm
- Public holidays (except Christmas/New Year's days) & Sundays: 9am-5pm

Refuse/recycling collection

There will be no change to collection of refuse/recycling. They will be collected on Friday 27 December and Friday 3 January as usual.

Liquor bans

There are alcohol-free zones in place for:

- Ōtaki Beach from 9pm to 6am, every day
- public places located in or adjacent to the urban areas of Main St/Mill Rd, Aotaki St, Ruakawa St, Rangatira St and Waeranga Rd - 24 hours/7 days
- Ōtaki skateboard park and reserve - 24 hours/7 days.
