<p><u>Kiosk at Paraparaumu Beach</u> Members questioned that as the Kiosk was being leased, would there be any requirements needed for further fire protection?</p>	<p>The Kiosk refurbishment has all the necessary requirements for fire protection.</p>
<p><u>Kapiti Arts Trail</u> Members requested it be covered over two weekends and also must not clash with the Toast Martinborough Festival.</p>	<p>At the last Arts Trail planning meeting (March) it was agreed that the 2015 Kapiti Arts Trail event: a) would be scheduled to avoid Toast Martinborough and any other major events with overlapping audience; and b) it would run over 2 weekends.</p>

<p>Local Alcohol Policy – Update Members at the next RMC on how the Policy would align with other Councils where appropriate.</p>	<p>Members were updated at the Regulatory Management Committee on 12 March 2015</p>
<p>Official Information Act (OIA) requests - Useful to track the number of OIA's over the years and how many were charged.</p>	<p>This information would be reported back to the Audit &amp; Risk Subcommittee</p>
<p>Members requested an update on the solar panels at Ōtaki Pools.</p>	<p>The solar panels are in place in Ōtaki and are providing heat to the toddlers' pool which in turn provides some heat to the main pool. A recent upgrade means that the pool will be more energy efficient and make the most of the solar system. The panels can be removed for the roof replacement and reinstalled once construction is complete.</p>
<p>Eric Gregory requested an update on whether there will or will not be solar panels at the Waikanae Pools</p>	<p>Solar at Waikanae was considered back in 2010. The problem was where to put a collector that was large enough to serve a significant proportion of the pool's heat needs. There was also the issue of vandalism and weight. Unglazed panels are lighter and more durable, but they are larger than glazed ones per unit of heat produced – needing more space.</p> <p>At this stage there is no plan for solar panels at Waikanae Pool. It is something that could be considered further in the future but there are issues (as described above) that would need to be worked through.</p>
