Hearings will be later in 2013.</p> <p>A summary of Coastal submissions (424) was notified for further submissions on Thursday 20 June (until 18 July 2013).</p> <p>Pre-hearing meetings for Chapter 5 (Living Environment) and Chapter 7 (Rural Environment) have concluded and the Living Environment hearing is scheduled for mid August.</p> <p>For more information please visit the District Plan Review website.</p>	
<p>Resource Consents</p>			<p><u>Appeals</u></p> <p>There are currently no Appeals to the Environment Court.</p> <p><u>Notified Applications</u></p> <p>The Notices of Requirement and resource consents from Transpower NZ Ltd in relation to the Paraparamu Supply Connection Project were publicly notified on 23 May. Submissions closed on Friday 21 June. There were 36 submissions, 33 in support, two neutral and one in opposition. The hearing to consider the applications will take place 29/30 July.</p> <p><u>Other consents</u></p> <p>There are no other consents of any particular significance.</p>	
<p>Collmog Bridge</p>			<p>As a consequence of the Beca report commissioned by Council, the building consent applicant is undertaking further assessment of the current bridge structure to confirm the best approach to resolve the issues with the Collmog Bridge.</p> <p>Staff have met with the applicant and agreed he will come back to Council after this work has been done. The dangerous building notice issued under Section 124 of the Building Act 2004 has been reissued with a deadline of 3 September 2013 for agreement with Council on the concept plan for the work.</p> <p>In conjunction with the dangerous building notice bollards have been installed to block access to the Collmog Bridge.</p>
