Alison Lash

Alison Lash, Council's Senior Advisor, spoke about the planned Road Shows on Natural Hazards in the District which were taking place at the Raumati South Memorial Hall on 9 June and Paraparaumu Memorial Hall on 16 June.

Ms Lash explained that the current District Plan Review included new information on seismic hazards and climate hazards and then gave some specific details about the climate hazards throughout the District (paper was tabled).

- Climate change;

- Flood Hazards and their implications for the District;
- Current global trends in natural hazards showing the variation between 1950-2004;
- Publicity/format of the Road Shows; and
- Details that were available at Road Shows would also be available online.
