PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1 Five applications for a Discretionary Grant have been received from:
 - Paraparaumu Playcentre
 - Kapiti Kids Motivation Trust
 - Lighthouse Family Trust
 - Raumati South School
 - Kapiti Timebank

These applications comply with the Discretionary Grants criteria and need to be considered by the Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board.

SIGNIFICANCE OF DECISION

- 2 The recommendations in this report do not trigger the Council's Significance Policy.

BACKGROUND

- 3 An amount of \$20,370 was provided in the 2012/13 budget for the Community Grants Fund. This is the second allocation of grants for the 2012/13 year.

- 5 Five applications have been received for funding from the Community Grants Fund.
- 6 The applicants have been advised of the criteria and meeting date either by telephone or by letter.

Applications from the Community Grant Fund

Paraparaumu Playcentre

- 7 Devina McGhie on behalf of the Paraparaumu Playcentre has applied for a grant of \$199 for the cost of the amended building consent fee.

This application can be considered under Eligible Purposes 4; *To partially or fully offset the cost of any Council permit, licence or resource consent fees within the current financial year of the project or activity.*

Kapiti Kids Motivation Trust

- 8 Roger Booth, on behalf of the Kapiti Kids Motivation Trust has applied for a grant of \$500 to assist with the cost of bringing sporting and cultural identities into the Kapiti Coast to inspire, encourage and motivate children.

This application can be considered under Eligible Purposes 2; *Special project or activity.*

Lighthouse Family Trust

- 9 The Lighthouse Family Trust has applied for a grant of \$431.25 to cover the cost of renting an 'Aircastle' for their Annual Community Event 'Alternative Halloween Hoedown'.

Raumati South School

- 10 Raumati South School has applied for a grant of \$500.00 to cover the cost of trees and safe access steps around their bushwalk.
