**GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS**

3. Percentage Towards Establishing QEII Covenants

That Council enters into an agreement with the Queen Elizabeth National Trust to provide a guaranteed contribution to any new covenant established on the Kapiti Coast. The contribution would be given on a “first in, first served” basis and would be automatic providing there are funds available. Council’s contribution would be paid directly to the Trust who would then establish the covenant. The contribution would be based on the Trust continuing in a management and advisory role with the landowner.

The contribution for a covenant would be split four ways:

Queen Elizabeth Trust:	All legal costs & ¼ fencing costs
Wellington Regional Council:	½ survey costs & ¼ fencing costs
Kapiti Coast District Council:	½ survey costs & ¼ fencing costs
Landowner:	¼ fencing costs
