APPOINTMENT OF COUNCILLORS TO COMMUNITY BOARDS

PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1 This report seeks to formalise the appointment of Ward Councillors to Community Boards in accordance with the Local Government Commission (LGC) Determination on Representation Arrangements for the Kāpiti Coast District Council.

SIGNIFICANCE OF DECISION

- 2 The report does not trigger Council's Significance Policy.

BACKGROUND

- 3 The Local Government Commission in its determination of the membership and basis of election of the Kāpiti Coast District Council issued on 9 April 2010 made provision for the appointment of Councillors back to Community Boards. The relevant extract of the Determination is at Appendix 1.

CONSIDERATIONS

Issues

- 4 In effect the LGC determined that all Ward Councillors would be appointed back to Community Boards with both Paraparaumu Ward Councillors being appointed back, in recognition of that Board's greater representational workload.

- 6 Appointments are set forth in accordance with the Local Government Commission Determination of 2010.

Extract from the Local Government Commission's Determination for the Representation Arrangements for the Kāpiti Coast District Council

47. Under section 19R of the Local Electoral Act 2001, the Commission determines that for the general election of the Kāpiti Coast District Council to be held on 9 October 2010 the following representation arrangements apply –

(1) Kāpiti Coast District as delineated on SO Plan 35973 deposited with Land Information New Zealand, is divided into four wards.

(2) The four wards are:

- (a) the Ōtaki Ward, comprising the area delineated on SO Plan 335001 deposited with Land Information New Zealand;
- (b) the Waikanae Ward, comprising the area delineated on SO Plan 35977 deposited with Land Information New Zealand;
- (c) the Paraparaumu Ward, comprising the area delineated on SO Plan 35976 deposited with Land Information New Zealand;
- (d) the Paekākāriki-Raumati Ward comprising the area delineated on SO Plan 37410 deposited with Land Information New Zealand.

(3) The Council comprises the mayor and 10 councillors elected as follows:

- (a) one councillor elected by the electors of the Ōtaki Ward;
- (b) one councillor elected by the electors of the Waikanae Ward;
- (c) two councillors elected by the electors of the Paraparaumu Ward;
- (d) one councillor elected by the electors of the Paekākāriki-Raumati Ward;
- (e) five councillors elected by the electors of Kāpiti Coast District as a whole.

(4) The district is divided into four communities as follows:

- (a) the Ōtaki Community, comprising the area delineated on SO Plan 430955 deposited with Land Information New Zealand;
- (b) the Waikanae Community, comprising the area delineated on SO Plan 430944 deposited with Land Information New Zealand;
- (c) the Paraparaumu-Raumati Community, comprising the area delineated on SO Plan 335002 deposited with Land Information New Zealand;
- (d) the Paekākāriki Community, comprising the area delineated on SO Plan 36762 deposited with Land Information New Zealand.

(5) The membership of the Ōtaki Community Board is comprised of four members elected by the electors of the Ōtaki Community and one member of Council representing the Ōtaki Ward and appointed to the community board by the Council.

(6) The membership of the Waikanae Community Board is comprised of four members elected by the electors of the Waikanae Community and one member of

Council representing the Waikanae Ward and appointed to the community board by the Council.

(7) The membership of the Paraparaumu-Raumati Community Board is comprised of four members elected by the electors of the Paraparaumu-Raumati Community and two members of Council representing the Paraparaumu Ward and appointed to the community board by the Council.

(8) The membership of the Paekākāriki Community Board is comprised of four members elected by the electors of the Paekākāriki Community and one member of Council representing the Paekākāriki-Raumati Ward and appointed to the community board by the Council.
