

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## **NOTIFICATION OF THE AVAILABILITY OF SUMMARY OF DECISIONS REQUESTED AND FURTHER SUBMISSION PERIOD FOR PLAN CHANGE 84 TO THE OPERATIVE DISTRICT PLAN – KAPITI COAST AIRPORT Clause 7 of Schedule 1 to the Resource Management Act 1991**

The Kapiti Coast District Council has accepted a request by Kapiti Coast Airport Holdings Limited to propose a plan change to the operative Kapiti Coast District Plan – Plan Change 84. The plan change seeks to change a number of the rules relating to the Airport Zone to allow resource consent to be sought for some retail activities and for noise sensitive activities outside the Air Noise Boundary.

Plan Change 84 was publicly notified on 24 February 2016, with the period for submissions closing on 23 March 2016. The Council received seven submissions on the plan change.

Pursuant to Clause 7 of Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991, the Kapiti Coast District Council gives public notice that a summary of the decisions requested by persons making submissions on Plan Change 84 (“summary”) has been compiled.

The Summary is now available to be viewed on the Council’s website at [www.kapiticoast.govt.nz/pc84](http://www.kapiticoast.govt.nz/pc84). It states the name of the submitter, the submission reference number (PC84-#), whether they support or oppose the provisions, and the decision they requested the Council make.

Copies of the Summary may be inspected or obtained at the Rimu Road Council Offices, Council Libraries and Service Centres during normal opening hours. Further submissions can now be made by a person who has an interest in Plan Change 84 greater than the interest that the general public has, or who is representing a relevant aspect of the public interest, or a local authority. It is not necessary for a person making a further submission to have made an original submission.

A further submission must be limited to a matter raised in an original submission and can be either in support or opposition to any particular part of that submission.

If you are eligible to make a further submission on a submission on Plan Change 84, you may do so by accessing the further submission form at [www.kapiticoast.govt.nz/pc84](http://www.kapiticoast.govt.nz/pc84) or otherwise following the prescribed form (Form 6 of the Resource Management (Forms, Fees and Procedure) Regulations 2003). It must be dated, signed by you (unless you make your submission electronically), and include:

1. your name, postal address and contact details;
2. the name and address of the original submitter and the number of the submission to which you are making a further submission;

3. whether you oppose or support that submission and the particular parts that you support or oppose;
4. the reasons for your support or opposition;
5. whether you seek that the whole (or part) of the submission be allowed or disallowed; and
6. whether you wish to be heard in support of your further submission.
