HortNZ made submissions and further submissions relating to the trimming of vegetation and supported changes Federated Farmers sought to Chapter 3. HortNZ supports the relief sought as it will provide for necessary trimming of indigenous vegetation for farming activities.

Appeal point 6 – Rule 3A.3.8 Trimming or modification of indigenous vegetation

HortNZ made submissions and further submissions relating to the trimming of vegetation and supported changes Federated Farmers sought to Chapter 3. HortNZ supports the relief sought as it will provide for necessary trimming of indigenous vegetation for farming activities.

HortNZ made submissions and further submissions relating to Rule 7A.1.2. HortNZ supports the relief sought to ensure that shelterbelt planting is able to be undertaken as a permitted activity.

Appeal point 15 – Definition National Grid Yard

Appeal point 16 – Policy 11.2 Reverse sensitivity

HortNZ supports the relief sought to ensure that there is a clear distinction between sensitive and non-sensitive activities in the National Grid Yard and that the provisions should only apply to the National Grid to give effect to the National Policy Statement for Electricity Transmission.

Appeal point 17 – Policy 11.22 National Grid and high Pressure Gas Transmission lines

HortNZ made submissions and further submissions relating to the Electricity Transmission provisions in the plan. HortNZ supports the relief sought to ensure that there is a clear distinction between sensitive and non-sensitive activities in the National Grid Yard, that access be deleted from the policy and that the provisions should only apply to the National Grid to give effect to the National Policy Statement for Electricity Transmission.

Appeal point 18 – Permitted Activity Rule 11C.1.1

HortNZ made submissions and further submissions relating to the Electricity Transmission provisions in the plan. HortNZ supports the relief sought to delete Rule 11C.1.1 to ensure that the provisions are consistent with NZECP 34:2001.

Appeal point 19 – Permitted Activity Rule 11C.1.4

HortNZ made submissions and further submissions relating to the Electricity Transmission provisions in the plan. HortNZ supports the relief sought to delete Rule 11C.1.4 to ensure that the provisions are consistent with NZECP 34:2001.

Appeal point 20 - Restricted Discretionary Rule 11C.3.1

HortNZ made submissions and further submissions relating to the Electricity Transmission provisions in the plan. HortNZ supports the relief sought to delete Rule 11C.3.1 to ensure that the provisions give effect to the National Policy Statement for Electricity Transmission.

Appeal point 21 Rule 12D.1.2 Permitted Activity standards for noise

HortNZ made submissions on provisions relating to noise in the rural area. HortNZ supports the relief sought to ensure that primary production activities are included in 12D.1.2.4 to be exempt from the noise standards in 12D.1.2.1.
