

## PUBLIC NOTICE

### NOTIFICATION OF AVAILABILITY OF SUMMARY OF DECISIONS REQUESTED AND FURTHER SUBMISSION PERIOD FOR URBAN TREE VARIATION TO PROPOSED KAPITI COAST DISTRICT PLAN

The Kapiti Coast District Council is changing the way it describes trees protected under the Proposed District Plan (PDP), as a result of amendments to the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA). The Urban Tree Variation (UTV) is the means by which the Council is intending to meet the RMA requirements.

Pursuant to Clause 7 of Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991, the Kapiti Coast District Council gives public notice that a summary of the decisions requested by persons making submissions on the Urban Tree Variation to the Proposed Kapiti Coast District Plan ("Summary") has been compiled.

The Summary is now available to view at [www.kapiticoast.govt.nz](http://www.kapiticoast.govt.nz). It states the name of the submitter, whether they support or oppose the provisions, and the decision they requested Council make.

Further submissions can now be made by a person who has an interest in the Urban Tree Variation greater than the interest that the general public has, or who is representing a relevant aspect of the public interest, or a local authority. It is not necessary for a person making a further submission to have made an original submission.

A further submission must be limited to a matter raised in an original submission and can be either in support or opposition to that submission.

If you are eligible to make a further submission on a submission on the Urban Tree Variation you may do so by accessing the further submission form at [www.kapiticoast.govt.nz](http://www.kapiticoast.govt.nz) or otherwise following the prescribed form (Form 6 of the Resource Management (Forms, Fees and Procedure) Regulations 2003). It must be dated, signed by you (unless you make your submission electronically), and include:

1. your name, postal address and contact details;
2. the name and address of the original submitter and the number of the submission to which you are making a further submission;
3. whether you oppose or support that submission and the particular parts that you support or oppose;
4. the reasons for your support or opposition;
5. whether you seek that the whole (or part) of the submission be allowed or disallowed; and
6. whether you wish to be heard in support of your further submission.
