BACKGROUND

- 3 An amount of \$21,850 is provided in the 2018/19 budget for the Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board and grants are funded from that budget.
- 4 Accountability reports on grants allocated are required two months after the event or activity for which the grant was awarded takes place.

CONSIDERATIONS

Policy Considerations

- 5 Grants are allocated in accordance with established criteria (attached to this report as Appendix 1).

Applications to the Community Grants Fund

- 6 The following applications were considered at the Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board meeting of 19 June 2018. Due to the grants budget having been fully allocated, the applications were left to lie on the table for consideration at the next Board meeting:

Babes + Picnics

- 7 Funding of \$100 is sought to assist with the cost of paying for an indoor venue for monthly picnics aimed at connecting Mums to other mothers and their community.
- 8 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 5: *The remission of hall rental.*

Nicola Easthope

- 9 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of appearing as a Guest Poet at the 2018 Tasmanian Poetry Festival, being held in October 2018.
- 10 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity.*

Emily Gannon

- 11 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of competing at the World Hip Hop Championships to be held in Phoenix, Arizona, in August 2018.
- 12 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity.*

Riley James

- 13 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of competing at the World Amateur Snooker Championships in China, in July 2018.
- 14 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity.*

Kapiti Ballet Society

- 15 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of hiring the Southwards theatre for the 2018 'Dance Kapiti' competition, which will run from 13 – 17 July 2018.

- 16 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 5: *The remission of hall rental.*

Mulled Wine Concerts

- 17 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of transporting a Celtic harp from Christchurch to Paekakariki, as well as contributing to publicity and printing costs, for a concert on 22 July 2018.
- 18 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity.*

Paraparaumu College – Sheilah Winn Shakespeare Nationals Team

- 19 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost for students to participate in the National Shakespeare Festival in Wellington, on 2 – 4 June 2018.
- 20 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity.*

Fernando Figueroa Pereira

- 21 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of instruments and equipment for music students.
- 22 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity.*

Raumati South Kindergarten

- 23 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of holding the fundraising event 'The Big Shwop Kapiti', which is raising funds for the kindergarten's outdoor play equipment and learning resources.
- 24 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity.*

Devon Welch

- 25 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of attending an Outward Bound outdoor education course, commencing 30 July 2018.
- 26 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity.*

- 43 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity*.

Jack Penman

- 44 Funding of \$470 is sought to assist with the cost of creating a photographic exhibition of the Paraparaumu Beach Saturday Market.
- 45 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special project or activity*.

Financial considerations

- 46 The amount available in the 2018/19 budget is \$21,850.
- 47 This is the first round of grant applications for consideration in the current financial year.
- 48 The total amount of grants for consideration in this report is \$7,500.00.
