Thank you for your email of 30 January 2023 requesting the following information:

1. How are citizenship ceremonies run across your district/city, are they just run by council staff, privately organised, etc.?

Citizenship ceremonies held by Council are organised by council staff with support from local suppliers, with input and funding from the Department of Internal Affairs (DIA).
