Request for Information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) (the LGOIMA)

Thank you for your email of **22 June 2026** requesting the following information:

I am seeking information about publicly accessible toilet facilities for use in a free public-interest website aimed at helping people locate and understand available toilet facilities throughout New Zealand.

I request any information held relating to publicly accessible toilet facilities that are owned, operated, maintained, funded, managed, or otherwise recorded by your organisation.

Where photographs are held, I would appreciate copies where practical, ideally named using the facility name, asset identifier, or another identifier that allows them to be matched to the facility record. For the avoidance of doubt, “publicly accessible” includes facilities that may only be available during opening hours or while premises are open to visitors.

Please find attached an Excel spreadsheet containing the information we hold in relation to your request. We do not hold associated photographs. Accordingly, this part of your request is refused under section 17(e) of the Act as the documents alleged to contain the information requested do not exist, or despite reasonable efforts to locate them, they cannot be found.

Please note that any information provided in response to your request may be published on the Council website, with your personal details removed.
