SUBMISSION TO THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT ON THE DRAFT GOVERNMENT POLICY STATEMENT ON LAND TRANSPORT (GPS) 2018 (SP-18-492)

Dr Griffin and Ms Itjeshorst spoke to this report. Dr Griffin explained that although the closing date for submissions was yesterday, an interim submission had been made and permission granted for changes to be made to that submission after today's Committee meeting.

Suggestions included:

- Where reference is made to advocating for public transport (paragraph 23), that explicit reference be made to the need for the railway line to be extended north to Otaki
- Make clearer the importance of well-built infrastructure and alternative modes of transport in resilience planning
- Strengthen the wording around Council's concern about the ability to meet the expected local share of funding, and make available increased funding assistance specifically in relation to new road safety initiatives
- The road safety section should emphasise the need for creating better drivers e.g. through education, training etc and also ensuring adequate police resourcing
- At paragraph 11, include the observation that transport options create employment options
- The funding section should include reference to funding for "cross-boundary" projects e.g. the rail connection from Wellington to the Manawatu
- At paragraph 6, emphasise Council's strong desire to participate in the development of the new road safety strategies
- There should be stronger emphasis on the need for alternatives to private cars
- At paragraph 11, the wording should be changed from 'As a medium growth Council...' to 'As a Council that is looking at high growth...'

With the above suggested amendments the motion was put.
