# **Background**

The object of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 is that the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol should be undertaken safely and responsibly; and the harm caused by the excessive or inappropriate consumption of alcohol should be minimised.

It is a legal requirement of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 that you must have a licence before you can sell or supply alcohol.

# Before lodging application

Once this application is complete then you must ring and make an appointment for a pre-lodgement meeting with the Licensing Inspector. Please Telephone (04) 296 4700 or Toll Free: 0800 486 486. The application forms cannot be accepted by the DLC over the counter until they have been signed off as complete by the Inspector and a fee category has been calculated.

You should also apply for certificate of compliance with the Resource Management Act and the Building Act from the Kapiti Coast District Council.

# Lam Lee Limited Licence Number 45/OFF/052/2022

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), Lam Lee Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 5 Parata Street, Waikanae and known as Waikanae New World, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

### **Conditions**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Alcohol is only permitted to be sold, supplied or delivered on or from the premises authorised by the licence.
- 2. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- 3. All deliveries of alcohol must be verified by a person aged 18 years or over.
- 4. No alcohol may be sold other than
  - (i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
  - (ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
  - (iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
  - (iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
  - (v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- 5. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

### Monday to Sunday - 7am to 11pm

- 6. The whole of the premises is **undesignated**.
- 7. The **single alcohol area** (the only permitted area for the promotion and display of alcohol) is defined on the plan approved on 6 July 2019 and encompasses the area in the front (southwest) corner of the store.
- 8. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and to intoxicated persons.
- 9. The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the safe and responsible consumption of alcohol, and minimising alcohol related harm.
- 10. A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance, the principal entrance is defined as the entrance from the car park.

## Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either-
  - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
  - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

Check-out Operators are NOT PERMITTED to share drawer/till at any time or for any reason! Failure to do so will result in written warnings to the Check-out operators involved.

All Refunds or Voids must have the corresponding paper work with the Supervisor's names and signature on it and kept in the cash drawer/till.

An explanation will be required for any unexplained shortages in your cash drawer/till. You will be required to undergo re-training.

Supervisors are not permitted to use other Check-out operators till without their consent.

Management Procedures will be undertaken as a consequence of unexplained till shortages.

# Sale of Alcohol and Restricted items








# Attachment 2: Plan of licensed area
