

In the matter of an application by Global Wines & Spirits Limited for renewal of an Off Licence pursuant to section 127 of the Act in respect of premises situated at 42B Main Street, Otaki known as Big Barrel Otaki.

MINUTE OF THE KAPITI COAST DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE – NOTICE OF DLC HEARING for renewal of OFF858 Global Wines & Spirits Limited Off Licence.

The Kapiti District Licensing Committee having considered the papers in relation to the application by Global Wines & Spirits Limited have determined the Applicant shall have the opportunity to present its application to a hearing of the Kapiti DLC.

The primary issue of contention is the applicant's refusal to accept the condition requiring a signature from a person aged 18 or over receiving alcohol deliveries. See below excerpt from the letter solicitor John Young of Brookfields Lawyers, acting for Global Wines & Spirits, sent with the application to the Inspector on November 30, 2023:

As discussed, my client does not agree to a condition that states "All deliveries of alcohol must be signed for by a person aged 18 years or over". The reason for this is that a third party makes deliveries and therefore BB cannot completely control the systems and processes of that third party.

There is also the secondary issue of extended hours – The applicant has applied to extend trading hours to be 9am to 10pm Monday to Sunday which is an increase of 21 hours per week.
