PRESENTATION: KAPITI ISLAND MARINE RESERVE MAPPING PROJECT – PROF JONATHAN GARDNER AND DR GEOFFROY LAMARCHE

The Chair introduced Jonathan Gardner, Professor of Marine Biology, Victoria University of Wellington and Dr Geoffroy Lamarche, Principal Scientist specialising in Marine Geology from NIWA.

They provided an update to the Committee on why and how they have mapped the submarine landscape of Kāpiti Island. They briefly described the production of highly accurate bathymetry, habitat and biotope maps of the seafloor, and how this information will contribute towards assessing the ecological integrity of Kāpiti's marine environment.

The next steps are

- looking at the link between physical and biological habitats;
- constructing a biophysical habitat map;
- collating the large volume of data that has been collected and working on this over the next five years.

They showed the Committee footage from a recent dive at the Kāpiti Island Marine Reserve.

KAPITI COAST DISTRICT COUNCIL FIRE PREVENTION BYLAW (RS-17-118)

Mr Kevin Currie, Group Manager Regulatory Services spoke to this report.

The main points that came out of discussion are that the Fire and Emergency New Zealand Transition (FENZ) Team are still working through the process and will work with the Kāpiti Coast District Council to make sure this process runs smoothly. The Community needs to be aware that the process is changing and that Council need to assist with the process going smoothly which would include publicity. The Act comes into effect on 1 July 2017 and the Transition Team acknowledge the need to have a transition regime in place by the time the Council's bylaw expires on 30 September 2017.

Council Officers did make a submission to the FENZ Project Committee on the changes and have been in contact with the FENZ Transition team, and expect to meet with them soon to initiate the handover.

That the Strategy and Policy Committee recommends to Council that:

- a) the review of the Kāpiti Coast District Council 2010 Fire Prevention Bylaw is stopped; and**
- b) the Kāpiti Coast District Council 2010 Fire Prevention Bylaw is allowed to expire on 30 September 2017.**

- c) the Committee directs that staff advocates to Fire Emergency New Zealand for acceptable implementation, delivery and communication of the new regulations.**


