I refer to your information request we received on 8 June 2022 for the following:

In reference to your comment:

The comment there was ‘from your view no difference between what was contracted and what was produced other than a title change’ is inaccurate. The work has not been completed, the full scope of works have not yet been produced. Only Volumes 1 & 2. On completion of Volume 3 - which is currently underway.

Could you please provide the documented communication between Council and Jacobs regarding Volume 3 only - emails, memos, telephone notes, meeting minutes etc.

The Takutai Kāpiti: Coastal hazards adaptation decision-making framework provides detail regarding the next stage of the project, including a diagram outlining the Volume 3 body of reporting that is part of this phase, it is available online via the following link:

This report will help to answer your misunderstanding regarding the work currently underway and required to be completed for the Takutai Kāpiti project.
