




- [1] The Council's reports and information on the submissions and any pre-circulated information from the submitters will be made available on the Council website.
- [2] The Council's hearing administrator is currently preparing the hearing timetable to give people slots for the hearing.
- [3] For the two days dated 30 and 31 March 2023 the Panel will sit at Ōtaki at the Raukawa Marae. The Council's hearing administrator will encourage any Ōtaki-based submitters to present there. Otherwise, the venue is the Kāpiti Sports Turf Pavilion, 10 Scaife Drive, Paraparaumu.
- [4] To enable a timetable to be constructed we direct that all submissions be confined to a 20 minute slot unless expressly authorised by the Panel. Requests for a longer time slot should be directed to the Council's hearing administrator at [district.planning@kapiticoast.govt.nz](mailto:district.planning@kapiticoast.govt.nz).
- [5] Kāinga Ora requested half a day and given the scope of their submission and the nature of their interest this request has been accepted.
- [6] The Panel's expectation is that any person presenting evidence is available to answer questions. While any written evidence that does not meet the standard will be considered our inability to test that evidence may affect the weight we place on it.
