Request for Official Information responded to under the Local Government and Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA) (the Act) – reference: OIR 2122-144

I refer to your information request we received on 26 November 2021 in relation to our response to OIR 2122-113 for the following:

1. The OIR response makes clear that the [Takutai Kapiti Panel Meeting 29 September 2021] "meeting was not recorded", could you please provide the documentation that the Council relied upon to make this decision - to not record minutes.

Audio recordings are not automatically made of all meetings organised by Council, which are not official 'meetings' under the LGOIMA.

The Takutai Kāpiti Panel meetings are recorded by way of agenda, minutes and copies of presentations. These are published on the Takutai Kāpiti website following sign off by the panel members at each subsequent meeting.

2. In reference to the site visit, the OIR states:, "The sites were chosen by Jacobs." Could you please provide all documentation from Jacobs to Council regarding the 6 November site visit.

Please refer to Attachment 1 - Site Visit Emails. You will see that the personal details of other parties have been withheld from this information. The decision to withhold this information is made under section 7(2)(a) of the Act which allows for Council to withhold information in order to protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons.

In the Council's view the reasons for withholding these details are not outweighed by public interest considerations in section 7(1) favouring their release.

3. Lastly, could you please provide the cost of the 7 November communications training


Kia ora,
