Re: Stand for Children Services - request for grant

I am writing to support the application from Stand Children's Services for a financial contribution towards the cost of holding a reunion for people who have worked or stayed as children at the Otaki Children's Health Camp over the past 85 years.

The interest in holding a reunion has come from the awareness raised about the Camp's history as a result of the book I have written (*Sun, Sea and Sustenance*) which will be launched at the Otaki Museum in conjunction with the opening of an exhibition on the Health Camp. As you are probably aware, the Otaki camp was the first permanent children's health camp established in New Zealand and was made possible by Byron Brown's gifting of the land required.

Last year the Otaki Community Board provided me with a grant of \$500 to help cover the costs involved in undertaking the research on the Health Camp. Over the last 18 months I have interviewed over 50 people, many of them from the local area but some from as far away as Australia and England. I very much appreciated the assistance you provided in covering the cost of my travel to interviews within New Zealand. Many of the people interviewed (even some of those now living overseas) indicated that they would love to have a reunion. I am delighted that Stand for Children Services have agreed to organise such an event but I know they do not have much in the way of surplus funds and hence this application.

There are thousand s of people all over New Zealand (and Australia) who have stayed or worked at the camp at some time. I expect that only a hundred or so will be interested in attending a reunion but that will be enough to make this quite a splendid and historically important event for Otaki. I hope the Board will look on this application favourably.
