Reason for objection: The original classification, zoning maps and descriptions initially specified by the Kapiti Council were an appropriate reponse to the government's required changes and to support housing growth effectively in appropriate areas. The changes proposed by this submitter are overly extensive and out of keeping with the local unique character of the kapiti coast and specifically the Parapapaumu Beach area (since I have to comment on areas where I have a greater interest than the general public). Paraparaumu Beach is a local seaside village of unique character which is what attracts new residents and visitors & is the reason I chose to move here). Turning this area (outined in appendix 4 maps sheet 6 & 7) into a high density housing zones with building the height they are proposing will distroy this unique character and put significant pressure on already strained infrastructure - e.g. stormwater drains and pollution which already cause issues - extensive alge polluting the sand along many areas of the beach from resident pumps.
