s097.05 Partially support/oppose - Support principle of demand reduction, however KCDC ' s Grey water code of practice address ' s this. . Do not support second comment from GWRC, not sure how developers can reasonably ensure adequate water supply now and into the future. This seems like the responsibility of the TA to provide resilient networks and plan for future demand.

s097.26 Support this comment. There should be opportunity to encourage innovations and for the adoption and utilisation of new treatment technologies. To add to the comment, would also be good to include guidance about sludge disposal and WQ quality requirements for discharging to receiving environments.

s097.28 We partially support, high density in an area of high septic tank usage is not practical and the cumulative effects could be detrimental - more exploration is needed into this issue to ensure sustainable development.

s097.08 We acknowledge and support the sentiment of a greater focus on the climate change initiatives as part of plan change 2 and their importance in giving full effect to the NPS-UD

s097.09 We support further exploration and integration of the use of 'green infrastructure' to support developments. We acknowledge and support the sentiment of a greater focus on the climate change initiatives as part of plan change 2 and their importance in giving full effect to the NPS-UD.
