7 Alison Fitzmaurice, on behalf of Kapiti Powerlifting Club, has applied for funding of \$500 for three members to travel to Calgary, Canada to represent New Zealand at the World Powerlifting Championship in October 2019.

Kidz Need Dadz Wellington

8 Stuart Miller, on behalf of Kidz Need Dadz Wellington (KNDW), has applied for funding of \$500 plus GST to help with their annual KNDW Fathers' Day community event at Kapiti Ten Pin Bowling, Paraparaumu on 1 September 2019.

Mulled Wine Concerts

9 Mary Gow, on behalf of Mulled Wine Concerts, has applied for funding of \$500 for the delivery and removal of a piano and advertising on Beach FM for their closing concert on 11 August 2019.
