Request for Information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) (the LGOIMA)

Thank you for your email of 13 May 2025 requesting the following information:

I would like a copy of all documents, briefings, meeting minutes or reports about Kāpiti Coast Airport, dating from Jan 1, 2025.

On 26 May 2025 you clarified that:

I would like to refine the request to any information pertaining to the future development or use of Kāpiti Coast Airport

I can confirm that we have not identified any briefings, meeting minutes or reports that fall within the scope of your request. However, we have identified some email correspondence that falls within the scope of your request. Please find attached that correspondence.

Some of the information has been redacted because it is out of scope.

Some of the information is commercially sensitive and is withheld under section 7(2)(b)(ii) of the Act. Section 7(2)(b)(ii) provides that Council may withhold information in order to protect information where the making available of the information would be likely unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied it, or who is the subject of the information. I am satisfied that the withholding of this information is not outweighed by public interest considerations in section 7(1) favouring release.

The personal details of some individuals have been withheld from the information provided. The decision to withhold this information is made under section 7(2)(a) of

the Act which allows for Council to withhold information in order to protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons. I am satisfied that the withholding of this information is not outweighed by public interest considerations in section 7(1) favouring release.
