PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1 Five applications for funding have been received:
 - Coast Access Radio Trust
 - Kapiti Youth Support
 - Loved 4 Life
 - Matai Road Community Garden Group
 - Raumati South Residents' Association

DELEGATION

2 The Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board has delegated authority as at section D of the Governance Structure approved by Council on 26 October 2016:

Approving criteria for, and disbursement of, community-based grant funds as approved through the LTP or Annual Plan.

BACKGROUND

- 3 An amount of \$21,850 is provided in the 2018/19 budget for the Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board and grants are funded from that budget.
- 4 Accountability reports on grants allocated are required two months after the event or activity for which the grant was awarded takes place.

CONSIDERATIONS

Policy considerations

5 Grants are allocated in accordance with established criteria (attached to this report as Appendix 1).

Applications to the Community Grants Fund

Coast Access Radio Trust

6 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost for the organisation's Secretary to attend the Association of Community Access Broadcasters' Annual Conference and AGM in Christchurch, in October 2018.

7 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

Kapiti Youth Support

- 8 Funding of \$625 is sought to assist with the cost of participating in the Youth Art Exhibition in the 2018 Kapiti Coast Arts Trail.
- 9 This application was also put before the Waikanae Community Board at its meeting on 28 August 2018. The Waikanae Community Board indicated support of the application, but stated the amount it would grant would depend on how much may be granted to Kapiti Youth Support by the Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board.
- 10 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

Loved 4 Life

- 11 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of providing a quilt, knitted garments and a home-cooked meal to the families of newborn babies.
- 12 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

Matai Road Community Garden Group

- 13 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the costs of running the community garden, which includes the Council lease for the use of the land which costs \$205 per year.
- 14 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity and Eligible Purpose 4: To partially or fully offset the cost of any Council permit, licence or resource consent fees.

Raumati South Residents' Association

- 15 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of organising and operating an argentine ant baiting operation in Raumati South.
- 16 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

Financial considerations

- 17 An amount of \$21,850 was provided in the 2018/19 budget for the Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board. In addition, an amount of \$200 was returned by a group who had been granted funds but had subsequently closed down. This provides a total of \$22,050 available for granting in the current financial year.
- 18 To date in the current financial year, the amount of \$5,558 has been granted.
- 19 The balance remaining for granting in 2018/19 is \$16,492.
- 20 The total of applications under consideration in this report is \$2,000 plus whatever amount the Board may grant to Kapiti Youth Support.
