**Enquiry responded to under the Local Government and Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA) (the Act) – reference: OIR 2122-244**

I refer to your enquiry we received on 26 April 2022 for the following:

*I write in reference to a posting on the Takutai Kapiti website (screen shot attached).*

*The posting states: "Council has commissioned Jacobs Ltd to undertake a Coastal Hazard Susceptibility and Vulnerability Assessment..."*

*This statement seems to be at odds with information that I have received from Tim Power and Lyndsey Craig that Council (or Jacobs) do not hold any documentation supporting this commission. I refer you to my email to Councillors on Friday (22 April).*

- 1. If there is indeed a documented commission for a "Susceptibility and Vulnerability Assessment", I would appreciate if you could forward to me the relevant documents.*
- 2. In the absence of this documentation, I would appreciate if you would have the website edited as well as all other reference to reflect the deliverable 1 of Jacobs' Contract, which was for a Coastal Hazard and Risk Assessment - not a Susceptibility and Vulnerability Assessment.*

We have already responded to these matters raised in the 14 April 2022 email sent to you by Tim Power on behalf of Lyndsey Craig which answered this query. A copy is attached for your records.

We do not consider the statement on the website is misleading and we do not intend amending it.
