DELEGATION

- 2 The Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board has delegated authority as at section D.10 of the Governance Structure approved by Council on 11 June 2015:

Community Grants

- 10.13 *Authority to consider and approve the allocation of community-based grant funds as deemed appropriate under agreed criteria of both existing schemes and any granting schemes that may be approved through the Annual Plan process or the LTP process.*

BACKGROUND

- 3 An amount of \$21,506 is provided in the 2015/16 budget for the Community Grants Fund and is available for allocation in the current financial year.
- 4 To date the amount of \$6,250 has been granted in the current financial year.
- 5 The amount of \$15,256 remains available for granting in the current financial year.
- 6 Accountability reports on grants allocated are required two months after the event or activity for which the grant was awarded takes place.
- 7 All applicants have been advised of the meeting date by phone, email or letter.

CONSIDERATIONS

- 8 Grants are allocated in accordance with established criteria (copies provided under separate cover).

Applications to the Discretionary Grants Fund

Girl Guiding Paraparaumu

- 9 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of replacing the Girl Guides' camping gear which is becoming worn and outdated.
- 10 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special Project or Activity*.

Dayna Haylock

- 11 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of representing New Zealand at a 10 pin bowling tournament being held in Malaysia, in late November 2015.
- 12 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special Project or Activity*.

Kapiti Bowling Club Inc.

- 13 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of replacing the Bowling Club's barbecue which is used for community bowls evenings during the summer.
- 14 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special Project or Activity*.

Kapiti Chess Club

- 15 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of upgrading the Chess Club's equipment.
- 16 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special Project or Activity*.

Kapiti Community Singalong

- 17 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of renting the Paraparaumu Senior Citizens Hall for their monthly singalong meetings.
- 18 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 5: *The remission of hall rental*.

Kapiti Concert Orchestra

- 19 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of renting halls in Paekākāriki and Waikanae for orchestra rehearsals.
- 20 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 5: *The remission of hall rental*.

Jayden Puroku

- 21 Funding of \$485 is sought to assist with the cost of attending the New Zealand Basketball Academy Tour Camps to Las Vegas in November 2015 and January 2016.

- 22 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special Project or Activity*.

Patricia Te Huna

- 23 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of attending the New Zealand Indoor Mixed 30s Netball World Cup, being held in Brisbane in October 2015.
- 24 Although this event will already have taken place by the date of this meeting, the Chair has agreed to consider the application on the basis that the application itself was received prior to the event taking place. For this reason the application is still considered to be eligible.
- 25 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special Project or Activity*.

Te Newhanga Kapiti Community Centre

- 26 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of erecting a community noticeboard outside the centre.
- 27 This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: *Special Project or Activity*.
