TE MOANA INTERCHANGE WORKS

Work is ramping up in this area and we're about to begin upgrade works on Te Moana Road to prepare for the interchange. These works are similar to those you can see on Kāpiti Road and involve service installation, road widening, paving and kerbing. We expect the works to take around three months and thank you in advance for your patience and understanding while we carry out these works.

WHAT TO EXPECT

From Monday 9 May for three weeks, we'll be trenching along both sides of Te Moana Road between the Golf Club and Park Avenue, to install services and storm water pipes.

From next week for around a month we'll be carrying out pavement works on the eastern on and off ramps. We'll be using heavy machinery to construct the pavement layers and the work will finish around 100m either side of Te Moana Road.

In early June we'll start paving the existing Te Moana Road (under the bridge), starting on the northern side. This work shouldn't affect traffic as we'll be working off to the side of the road. Once we've completed this work we'll move traffic over onto the new roadway, so we can repair and rebuild the existing Te Moana Road (under the bridge).

Once road works under the bridge are completed, we'll rebuild a section of road extending approximately 200m back towards Park Avenue. This work should start around August and includes new kerbs, sections of driveway and the asphalt surface.


As part of this work and to tie in to the new Interchange, the road level will rise around 200mm at the intersection and will tie back in to the existing level over this distance.

Driveway reconstruction will be part of this work but if we're working across your driveway, you'll still be able to get in and out of your properties at all times.

Please take care in this area, observe speed restrictions and traffic management.

ACCESS LANE FOR TE MOANA PROPERTIES

TE MOANA ROAD DIVERSION

From 20 June for approximately two months, the temporary Te Moana Road diversion will be in place while we reconstruct Te Moana Road to tie into the Interchange.

This temporary diversion will be fully sealed and will carry traffic and pedestrians on the southern side of the current Te Moana Road. For everyone's safety there'll be a 30kph speed restriction in place.

WAIKANAE RIVER BRIDGE

We've successfully placed all 55 super tees at the Waikanae River Bridge. We'll now dismantle the 400tonne crane and will head back to the Wellington on 18 trucks.

We'll start placing 300 t of deck reinforcing that'll makes up the 180m long bridge and we've already completed one of twelve deck pours.
