**Council response regarding your request**

Please find enclosed attachments for all correspondence for the period June 1, 2021, to June 22, 2022. You will see that the personal details of other parties have been withheld from this information. The decision to withhold this information is made under section 7(2)(a) of the Act which allows for Council to withhold information in order to protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons. In the Council's view the reasons for withholding these details are not outweighed by public interest considerations in section 7(1) favouring their release.
