Proposed Plan Change 3 (PC3): Kārewarewa Urupā

Kārewarewa urupā is located in the area around Barrett Drive, Te Ropata Place, Marewa Place, and Tamati Place at Waikanāe Beach. PC3 proposes to incorporate Kārewarewa urupā into Schedule 9 of the District Plan (Sites and Areas of Significance to Māori) and amend the District Plan maps to include Kārewarewa urupā.
