I can confirm that:

- Officers have had a preliminary meeting about a proposal for an energy farm 27 November 2025. Attached is the pre-feasibility report submitted to Council for the 27 November meeting.
- Due to a lack of information the customer was advised to seek the advice of suitably qualified experts.
- Subsequent to this meeting council has not received any further information or requests for follow up meetings.
