



If other venues are not used to create a green park arent adopted tgen I submit using McLean Park given its ideal centraland accessible location. Leave the non pond parts as is. Extend the current pond to a minimum of 150 x 150 metres and a depth of 600-800mm. Have sloping lawns going down to edges but with a footpath surrounding it. Install a partial digression of the stream into and exiting the pond to replenish water reducing potential algael issues. Place some seating with appropriate cover for older citizens in particular to be out of the elements including the sun where applicable. I submit that ingress into the sandhill to the west of the current pond position could well accommodate this suggestion as well as allow for some of the changes proposed in the draft. The strengthening of the stream sides as draft proposes could easily be part of that extension to allow a proper pond as envisaged by my submission. We would need to include a wide pedestrian boardwalk linking the business district through Maclean Park.



Whales have featured big time on Pram beach so perhaps some sculptures could reflect that. How about interactive sculptures and what about dens or tunnels made out of woven flax?

b. Why do you want changes made?

I think it will be losing and amazing feature that will help with passive recreation; the pond AND is catering for young children as a priority rather people of all ages. 

It seems you have considered the requirements of everybody except those who have been using the area constantly for recreation for at least the last 50 years or so. There is no mention of the "Kapiti Underwater Club" that has been active for 50 years. Here are some facts for your consideration;

Prior to establishing the present coast guard in the area, this club provided, in conjunction with the local police, a major part of the first sea search & rescue services on this coast, whenever called upon dive club members never failed to provided their boats and services as volunteers (one senior member being awarded the police medal for his commitment).... No mention is made in your "Time Line" regarding the founding of the club and building of the club premises by its members in the 1970's... No mention of the recent fire and rebuilding of the club by its present members (present membership over 70 people, at a cost of \$300,000 using funds raised by the members through sponsors and working 'bees)... No mention of the different dive clubs that have been made welcome from different parts of the country to use the club facilities and explore the waters around the Island... No mention of the national spear fishing competitions and resulting fish auctions to raise money and the proceeds going to the Mary Potter Hospice... No mention of the collecting of fish and seafood from around Kapiti Islands by skin divers, scuba divers and the boating fraternity (of three generations) providing food for their families... No reference at all to a part of the Kapiti Coast community that actually spends much of it its recreational time in the sea, on the sea and under the sea that surrounds us, who spend hours of time on these beaches and dunes, who know by experience the vagaries of the sun, the wind, the rain, the currents, and the contrary moods the Cook Straight better than anyone, and us who love this area as it is and desire to change nothing at all.

In contrast, your plan simply indicates:- Build a Kapiti Island gateway and tourist information centre on the "existing boat club location" and a new beach access at the north end of the car park that is suitable for use by the commercial operators to facilitate boat launching and tourist trips to the Island. This being a most worthwhile improvement to the area..... As for the community mentioned above? Well, they can just move on.

In respect of this part of your proposed plan, I absolutely disagree that it is anywhere near being an improvement of facilities, in fact quite the opposite. As a rate payer and a person who has used this area, along with a large number other rate payers for recreational diving, fishing and family boating activities for 50 years or more, I feel one of your first obligations and commitments should be to cater for the group of people mentioned above. To do this you need to spend some time and find out what is actually going on in this area, because I find it staggering that, you i.e. the **Kapiti Borough Council** have only very recently approved and signed off on the new "Kapiti Underwater Club" rebuild certificate of compliance, yet you are totally unaware, even after 50 years of activity, that we exist!
