**Request for Information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) (the LGOIMA)**

Thank you for your email of **5 October 2023** requesting information regarding the Transport Hub and Town Centre Programme. I have provided answers to your questions (in bold) below.

***Could you please provide me with the prior allocations of funds for the \$8.3m transport Hub.***

***I have examined the KCDC reports on the annual plan and long term plan and cannot identify allocations for this expenditure. The LTP 2021-41 says at p82 there is an allocation for all Town centre connectors.***

***1. Please list all those connectors and what allocations were made in 2021 for each of them.***

P82 in the LTP 2021-41 sets out how much we are spending on all capital works associated with the Town Centres and Connectors programme each year. As priorities across the programme are changeable throughout the life of the LTP, the document does not specifically identify an allocation for every town centres project.

**2. Can you confirm that the extension of Ihakara St to Raumati was a town connector.**

There are no plans to extend Ihakara St to Raumati in the current LTP.

The Council is currently investigating connecting Ihakara St with Kapiti Rd, which was initially included in the Town Centres programme as P8 – Kapiti Relief Road and is now being undertaken as a separate project – listed as *Waka Kotahi East West Connectors* on page 82 of the LTP 2021-41.
