Request for Information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) (the LGOIMA)

Thank you for your email of **28 July 2025** requesting the following information:

Regarding the resource consent application for the proposed development of 17 double-story townhouses at 16, 18, and 20 Eruini Street, Waikanae Beach, by Palmer & Cook Developments. Could you please provide the following details:
