

Minute #5 of Independent Hearing Panel
Te Uruhi resource consent application - Marine Parade

1. We acknowledge receipt of a memorandum on behalf of the applicant today which responds to the information sought by the panel in Minute 4 and includes a refinement to the activities for which resource consent is sought, through removal of the car park extension.
2. The applicant also requests a shortening of the timetable set out in our Minute 4. We have considered this request and decline to amend the date by which any submitters wishing to comment on the material contained in the applicant's memorandum of today is due. This date will remain as Tuesday 8 November 2022.
3. If the section 42A officer's comments and applicants right of reply are able to be submitted earlier than the dates specified in Minute 4, then we encourage this, however, we do not require this.
4. The reason for the above determination is parties may have made arrangements based on the earlier dates set. In addition, one of the panel members will be away for 2 weeks from today, so the panel will be unavailable to consider feedback from submitters on the requested timetable change.
5. A reminder that any correspondence to the hearing panel should be directed through Emma Bean, however, the panel will be unable to consider any correspondence over the next two weeks. We ask that parties continue with the timetable as reconfirmed here.
